

Four Seasons Table Runner

6 hour class

This is a basic, beginning free-motion machine embroidery class. The main focus will be on learning to stitch **free motion**, to become comfortable with drawing and filling in shapes. We'll talk about various **stabilizers**, their use with **hoops** and how to hoop for best results, including how to wrap a hoop. We'll learn about tension adjustments for free motion and take away the fear of **bobbin tensions**.

Supplies

- Basic:** scissors, thread snips, pins
- Fabrics:** *4 sky fabrics, min. 7"x9.5"
*4 ground fabrics, min 4.5"x9.5"
- Stabilizer:** *light to medium weight tearaway, min. 10" square
- Threads:** 40 wt. Embroidery, rayon or polyester for shine
Colors: spring green, medium green, pink, white, med. brown, dark brown or black, apple red, rust or burgundy, orange, yellow
Regular weight sewing thread to sew sky to ground
Bobbin 50 wt. white thread, (The Bottom Line, BobbinFill, etc.)
- Sewing:** straight stitch and zig zag stitch
- Machine:** Cleaned and oiled before class
Darning Foot *and* regular sewing foot or ¼" foot
- Needle:** 80/12 topstitch
- Hoop:** 7.5" to 8" wrapped thin wooden machine embroidery hoop with adjustable screw (available for purchase in class, see optional kits)
Screwdriver for tightening
