

Dragon Fly Wonder

Supply List

(Pattern provided in class)

Minimum of 9 coordinating yet contrasting Fat Quarters – as you choose your fabrics, remember (when stacking and shuffling fabrics) each fabric will be in the block with the fabric underneath it, so there needs to be contrast. Stripes, dots, plaids, small prints, batiks, pastels, brights, country, or vintage; all of these styles work well. NOTE: Each fat quarter added creates one additional block, so a 20 block quilt needs 20 fat quarters. Not suited for large prints.

1 ½ yard for sashing (9 block quilt)

1 ¼ yard for outer border (9 block quilt)

Baby or Mini Rick Rack for dragon flies' antennas

Pen or pencil for tracing pattern to freezer paper (instructor to provide freezer paper)

Cutting Mat – large rotating cutting mat optional but nice

24" x 8 ½" ruler or 24" x 6 ½" ruler

15" or 14 ½" square ruler (for squaring blocks)

7 ½" square ruler (for squaring block sections)

4" x 14" ruler or something similar for cutting a part pattern

45mm or 60mm Rotary cutter & a new blade

Pins/Pin Holder/Scissors/Neutral Thread/Bobbins/et al
